

- 1. Vehicles with rear step only: First remove the two fixings each side connecting the Step to the brackets fixed to the chassis members. RETAIN FIXINGS.
- 2. Vehicles with rear step only: Remove the brackets from each chassis member, three fixings on the N/S chassis member, and two fixings on the O/S chassis member.
- 3. Vehicles without rear step: Remove Towing eye from left hand chassis member.
- 4. Locate all Towbar mounting points and ensure threads and mating faces are all clean and free from any under seal.
- 5. Using Item F and Item G loosely bolt Item A to the underside of the vehicle.
- 6. Using Item F and Item G bolt Items B to each correct chassis.
- 7. Using Item F with Item H bolt Items B to Item A.
- 8. Using Item E bolt your desired ball bracket and wiring plate (not supplied in this kit) to Item A.
- 9. Vehicles with rear step only: Using the original step fixings bolt the step to Item A using Item G if necessary as spacers.
- 10. Fully tighten all nuts and bolts ensuring Towbar is rigid and secure.



Note:

- 1. Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -130 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
