

Bumper / Round Tube removal:

- 1. If fitted remove the bumper / round tube from the vehicle, two fixings found on each outer chassis member.
- **2.** Remove the brackets from the bumper / round tube, and discard.

Towbar Installation:

- 1. Insert Item **D** into the open end of each chassis member and align over rearmost vertical mounting points.
- 2. Using Item **H** with Item **K** fit Items **C** to each correct chassis.
- 3. Using Item H with Item L loosely attach each side arm (Item B) to Items C.
- 4. Using Item **H** with Item **L** and ensuring Item **K** is fitted between Items **B** and the chassis members fit each side arm to the remaining Towbar mounting points on the vehicle.
- 5. Place Item A between side arms and fix in place using H with Item L.
- 6. Using Item G bolt your desired ball bracket and wiring plate (not supplied in this kit) to Item A.
- 7. If fitted, refit the rear bumper / round tube to Items B with Items J and M. NOTE: Bumper models use Item E as its new brackets using original fixings to attach bumper to Items E.
- **8.** Fully tighten all nuts and bolts ensuring Towbar is rigid square and secure. **NOTE:** vehicles fitted with rear bumper, ensure the rear bumper sits square to Towbar and vehicle.



Note:

- 1. Recommended Torque Setting for M12 Grade 10.9 -139 Nm. (For other Torque Settings see notes overleaf.)
- 2. Nose load limits and vehicle manufacturers trailer / caravan weight limits must be observed.
